Thank you for your March 31, 2010 gift of \$501.00 to Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) for our emergency response to the devastating earthquake that struck Haiti.

With your support, Doctors Without Borders has treated more than 41,000 patients and performed 3,400 surgeries at Doctors Without Borders locations in Port-au-Prince. We are providing surgical and emergency medical care, addressing the post-operative needs of our patients including rehabilitation, physiotherapy and mental health, and distributing tents, blankets, and hygiene and cooking kits to people still displaced or lacking sufficient shelter.

We anticipate that we will spend over \$75M in Haiti in 2010 on post-operative follow-up and ongoing care, distribution of relief items, and rebuilding of health care facilities. All contributions for Haiti are being used to fund our essential medical response there. Doctors Without Borders has worked in Haiti since 1991.
